

Luke Burbank

Burbank began his career in radio by pinch hitting across a variety of shows and genres, working either as a producer or as on-air talent. His work touched a number of shows, including *The Conversation, Rewind,* and *Day to Day.* He later became a reporter for NPR before starring as a regular panelist on the comedy show *Wait Wait... Don't Tell Me!* After a stint on *The Bryant Park Project* Burbank returned to Seattle to begin work on *Too Beautiful to Live.*

Jen Andrews

Jen Andrews served as producer for a variety of shows at KIRO before becoming executive producer of *Too Beautiful to Live*. The show marked the reunion of Burbank and Andrews, who had known each other since childhood. Andrews left the show for a time after its cancellation from radio and subsequent transition to the podcast format, but soon after rejoined Burbank as he broadcast from his home, "Burbank Studios."
